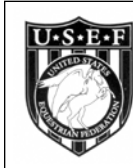


# SPECIAL EVENTS

## Class 300: \$25,000 Saratoga Cup National Standard Week 1

Time First Jump-Off, scored under USEF Table II, Sec. 2a. Horses must be on the grounds at least 24 hours prior to the start of this class. Check in time will be Saturday May 10 at 12:00 p.m. In the jump off, all horses will show in the original drawn order. Ties for all other placings will be separated by the time taken to complete the first round course. Riders are required to wear black, dark blue, dark green, or scarlet coats; white shirts with tie, stock, or choker; white, fawn, or canary breeches and hunt cap.



All Grand Prix held at this show are eligible for inclusion on the USEF Computer List. Certification Number(s) 8067

To be conducted and scored under Table II, Section 2(a) – Time First Jumpoff. Class specification as stated in current Zone specifications. Proper Attire Required.

Both horses and ponies are eligible to show in the Children's Hunter Classes or Classics; however, riders should be aware that the finals are offered at only one height, 3'.

**Entry Fee: \$65**


