HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION DIVISION

**Entry Fee: \$35 Per Class: 1-16
Trophy and Eight Ribbons**

Class 1: Maiden Equitation—Flat

Open to children who have not won a first ribbon in Hunter Seat Equitation. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Test 1.

Class 2: Maiden Equitation

Open to children who have not won a first ribbon in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 2'6".

Class 3: Maiden Equitation

Open to children who have not won a first ribbon in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 2'6".

Class 4: Maiden Equitation

Open to children who have not won a first ribbon in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 2'6".

Class 5: Novice Equitation—Flat

Open to children who have not won three first ribbons in Hunter Seat Equitation. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Tests 1-7.

Class 6: Novice Equitation

Open to children who have not won three first ribbons in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 2'9". Tests 1-7.

Class 7: Novice Equitation

Open to children who have not won three first ribbons in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 2'6".

Class 8: Novice Equitation

Open to children who have not won three first ribbons in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 2'6".

Class 9: Limit Equitation—Flat

Open to children who have not won six first ribbons in Hunter Seat Equitation. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1-7.

Class 10: Limit Equitation

Open to children who have not won six first ribbons in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 3'. Tests 1-7.

Class 11: Limit Equitation

Open to children who have not won six first ribbons in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 3'.

Class 180: Limit Equitation

Open to children who have not won six first ribbons in horsemanship over fences. Eight fences 3'.

There will be a Championship and Reserve Championship awarded in the Maiden, Novice, Limit Equitation Sections.

Class 12: Open Equitation—Flat

Open to Juniors 14 and under. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1-8.

Class 13: Open Equitation

Open to Juniors 14 and under. Eight fences 3'. Tests 1-8.

Class 14: Open Equitation

Open to Juniors who are 15-17. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Tests 1-19.

Class 15: Open Equitation

Open to Juniors who are 15-17. Eight fences 3'6". Tests 1-19.

Class 16: Adult Equitation on the Flat

Entry Fee: \$45 Per Class: 17-32

Trophy and Eight Ribbons

Class 17: Ralph P. Symmes Medal Class

Open ONLY to Junior Members of the CDHJC. A final class will be held at a designated show for those riders who qualify. The finals will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for the riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. Qualified riders will be sent an invitation to ride in this class, and only those riders so invited will be eligible to ride. Each show holding a qualifying class must be a member of CDHJC and must run this class over fences which will be a minimum of 3' and a maximum of 3'3" and may elect to use a flat phase in addition to but only on a 50/50 basis. A complete list of all entrants must accompany show results. The entry fee for this class will be the same as that of a regular open equitation class. A trophy and a minimum of six ribbons must be awarded. A minimum of three riders must complete the course in order for the class to be valid. Membership in the CDHJC may be made by a Junior wishing to show in this class on the day of the show. In this case, only Symmes Class points count that day—all other points begin to accumulate with the next recognized show. One (1) win or a total of five (5) points qualifies a rider for the the Finals. Qualified riders may continue to ride in the class. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st—5 pts.; 2nd—3 pts.; 3rd—2 pts.; 4th—1 pt. The annual CDHJC show may choose to offer two (2) Symmes classes. The Symmes Finals Medal Class may be won by an individual only once.

Class 18: Marshall Sterling Adult Medal (3')

Open to Adult and Amateur Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals.

Class 19: Ariat National Adult Medal

Fences not to exceed 3'.

Open to all Amateur members of the USEF and EC who are eligible to compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter Section at this show. **A rider may not compete at the same horse show in any hunter or equitation class in which the jumps exceed three feet, three inches (3'3").**

Class 20: NHSAA/ASPCA Maclay Class

Fences 3'6".

ASPCA HORSEMANSHIP CLASS. Open to Junior Riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Rider and trainer must be current members of the ASPCA/NHSAA, and must show their ASPCA numbers on the entry blank.

Class 21: National USEF/Pessoa Hunter Seat Medal Class

Fences 3'6".

Class 22: USEF Pony Equitation Class – Small

Fences 2'3".

Class 23: USEF Pony Equitation Class – Medium

Fences 2'6".

Class 24: USEF Pony Equitation Class – Large

Class 25: WIHS Pony Equitation Class

Competitors must be or join as WIHS Equitation members for points to count.

- The WIHS Equitation classes are open to junior members of USEF or CEF.
- **Three riders must complete the course for the class to be included in the National Ranking.**
- The same horse must be used in all phases of the event. **No exceptions.**
- One rider per horse, unless judge requests a change.
- Classes to be judged in accordance with the current USEF standards for equitation.
- Riders may only compete in one WIHS Equitation class at a show.
- Splitting of classes must be in accordance with USEF rules.

To be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles. Fence heights: 2'3" for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands; 2'6" for ponies over 12.2 hands and not exceeding 13.2 hands; and 3' for ponies over 13.2 hands and not exceeding 14.2 hands. If an in and out is used, the suggested distance for small ponies is 20', for medium ponies is 22', and for large ponies is 24'. The distance must be altered for each height division. A maximum of 20 riders may be asked to return to show at the walk, trot and canter and to perform any additional tests at the judges' discretion. Conventional tack per USEF rules.

Class 26: Platinum Performance/USEF Talent Search

Fences 3'6"–3'9".

USEF SHOW JUMPING TALENT SEARCH CLASS. A test of the abilities of an individual as a show jumping rider, is open to Junior/Young Riders who are members of the United States Equestrian Federation who have not reached their 21st birthday under USEF rules.

Open to all Junior Members of the USEF and EC who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6" (i.e.; USEF medal; ASPCA Maclay; USET Equine Canada Finals; WIHS Equitation).

To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. water obstacles are not permitted. The top four riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

TCRA riders: A minimum of three exhibitors must complete the course for points earned in this class to count toward TCRA Medal Finals qualification. The top fifteen riders accruing the most points in this class throughout the current show year shall qualify for the TCRA Junior Medal Finals.

Class 31: Marshall Sterling Children's Medal Horse

Open to Junior Riders who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required.

**Class 33: Governor's Cup Equitation Championship Classic
The Washington International Horse Show
Equitation Classic**

Members must be or join as WIHS Equitation members for points to count.

Entry Fee: \$50

- The WIHS Equitation classes are open to junior members of USEF or EC.
- Three riders must complete the course for the class to be included in the National Ranking.
- The same horse must be used in all phases of the event. No exceptions.
- One rider per horse, unless judge requests a change.
- Classes to be judged in accordance with the current USEF standards for equitation.
- Riders may only compete in one WIHS Equitation class at a show.
- Splitting of classes must be in accordance with USEF rules.

Conventional tack per USEF rules. Only running martingales used in the conventional manner are permitted in the Jumper Phase. Boots and conservative colored bandages are permitted in both phases.

The course should be of the type used in a Junior or Preliminary competition. To be shown over a minimum of 10 jumps at 3'6". A minimum of two double or one triple combination are required. There must be at least two changes of direction after the first fence. In addition, at least two of the following are required and more are recommended:

- Vertical - no ground lines
- Liverpool
- Narrow jump - minimum width 8'
- One or more of the following - triple bar, swedish oxer, fan jump

A Time Allowed will be used based on a speed of 360 yards per minute. The judge will give a numerical score for each competitor's round. The announcer will announce the judge's numerical score and then deduct time faults as follows: one point for each commenced second over the Time Allowed. Management may elect to hold the Jumper Phase as a Table II, 1.2c (Power & Speed) competition, in which case the Time allowed will apply only in the "speed" phase and must be computed at 382 yards per minute. Further testing will be optional; USEF tests 1-19.

Governor's Championship, Reserve Trophies and Cooler

To be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion of Class 33. A \$100.00 cash award will be presented to the instructor of the winning rider and a \$50.00 cash award to the instructor of the second place rider of Class 33.

Class 400: Leadline
